



Romans 6:23

We are those who have died to sin; how can we live in it any longer? ³ Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? ⁴ We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.

What Makes You a Christian?

Read Romans 6:23 and Ephesians 2:8-9.

Becoming a Christian (being saved, receiving eternal life) is a free gift from God. We cannot earn it ourselves.

- Being a good person does not make you a Christian.
- Being baptized does not make you a Christian.
- Accepting Jesus' free gift of salvation does make you a Christian.

How Do You Accept Jesus' Free Gift of Salvation?

- · Admit that you have sinned
- . Believe that Jesus died for you on the cross
- · Repent (turn away) from your sins and say you are sorry
- · Ask Jesus to come into your heart
- · Ask Jesus to take charge of your life and help you please him
