Let's start praying for the students who will be attending summer camp!

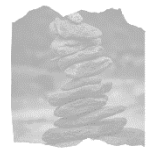
Pastor Nate plans to take a group from Cornerstone and Oasis to Word of Life Camps the week of July 16.

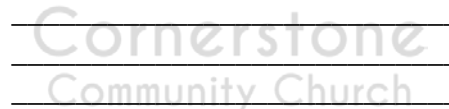
